#### **EVENT DESCRIPTION**

The event shall be held over three days. Friday 22nd May 2009 will be a Private Practice activity. Saturday 23rd May 2009 & Sunday 24th May 2009 will be a State Championship Race Meeting. All three days activities will be conducted at Sandown International Raceway and cars will circulate in an anticlockwise direction of the 3.1 km National Circuit.

#### **ENTRIES**

Entries will open on Monday 6th April 2009 and close on Friday 15th May 2009 except for the Friday practice activity for which entries close 10:00 am Friday 22nd May 2009. The entry fee for will be \$150.00 GST inc. for the Friday practice activity, and for Saturday/Sunday will be \$350.00 GST inc. for entries received up to **6th May 2009**, and \$380.00 GST inc. thereafter up until the closing date. The maximum number of entries accepted will be 356.

A surcharge of \$110 GST inc. applies to any entry which nominates for more than one category with the same driver. In these cases the driver must indicate on the entry form his/hers first and second choice of which category they would like to run. A separate full entry fee is payable if the cross entry is for the same vehicle but with a different driver. A separate full entry fee is also payable if a driver enters more than one category with a different vehicle. All drivers must be current financial members of clubs affiliated with CAMS and hold a PCC, CC, PC, NC, ICC or other type of license as approved.

#### **GARAGE HIRE**

There are a number of garages for hire. The garages are all doubles or triples and when you hire a garage you get a space measuring 8.5 meters deep and one car width across only, you do not get the entire double or triple garage. Whether you wish to share the garage, with one car behind the other, is up to you. No deposit is required but if the garage is not left in a clean and tidy state at the conclusion of the meeting, the organising committee reserves the right to charge the competitor a fee to do so. Garages will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

**PAYMENT**

Cheques and Money orders should be made payable to the MG Car Club Victoria. Entry Forms must be completed in full and accompanied by the entry fee and lodged with the Entry Secretary of the Meeting. Alternatively, payment can be made by Visa or Mastercard by filling out your card details on the payment page. Those wishing to use credit card facilities to pay for their entry fee and garage hire will incur an additional charge of 3% of the total transaction. There is a separate column on the payment page of the entry form to reflect this amount.

**CATEGORIES**

Qualifying / Racing will be provided for the following categories : Formula Vee, Formula Ford (1600 & Duratec), Mg/British, Sports Cars, HQ Holden, Improved Production, Sports Sedans, Super Karts, BMW E30 and 944 Challenge.

**CAR NUMBERS**

Preferred car numbers are to be requested on the entry forms. These will be allocated on a first come first served basis or if the categories have their own pre allocated numbers, then they will be used.

**FUEL**

Racing Fuel will be available for purchase at the circuit from JFP . Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the CAMS Manual.

**GENERAL**

- The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason thereto, in accordance with the provisions of NCR 83.
- Protests must be in accordance with Part XII of the NCR's.
- During any competition, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24-hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.
- Insurance has been affected by the promoter in accordance with Appendix I of the CAMS Manual.
- The promoter reserves the right to cancel. Postpone or abandon the event in accordance with NCR59.
- Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

**TARGETTED SCRUTINY**

Competitors/drivers must have had their Pre Race Inspection under the targeted scrutiny programme completed and must bring evidence of such to document check prior to commencing any track activity. The NCR 144 Declaration form will not be used anymore, however competitors must present themselves to scrutiny bay prior to competition where you will be issued with a scrutiny sticker which will permit you to go straight to the marshalling area when called to your first practice session. Please note that this does not mean your car will not be subject to scrutiny throughout the weekend.

**ANTI DOPING POLICY**

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

The CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such.

In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the Drugs in Sport Policy conflict, the Drugs in Sport Policy will take precedence.
